2017 Rare Neuro-Immune Disorders Symposium

In 1999, the TMA held its first international symposium about rare neuro-immune disorders, with more than 100 attendees from all over the world. Since then, we have held a symposium every other year to bring together individuals diagnosed with rare neuro-immune disorders and the clinicians and researchers that focus on these disorders.

As part of our continued commitment and mission to improve the quality of life of individuals diagnosed with rare neuro-immune disorders, the 2017 Rare Neuro-immune Disorders Symposium (RNDS) will be held on Oct 20-21, 2017 at the Hilton Columbus at Easton in Columbus, OH.

Hosted by The Transverse Myelitis Association (TMA), The Johns Hopkins Transverse Myelitis Center (JHTMC) and NMO Clinic, The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center (UTSW) and Children's Medical Center CONQUER Program, the symposium is dedicated to the exchange of information regarding diagnosis, research, and treatment strategies, and to providing an opportunity to bring together the community of individuals diagnosed with these rare neuro-immune disorders, families, caregivers, and the medical professionals who have interest and are specializing in these disorders.

2017 RNDS OBJECTIVES

- Gather an understanding of the knowledge to date on the biology and causes of rare neuro-immune disorders (ADEM, NMOSD, ON, TM, including AFM) and how they relate to each other
- Learn about the latest medical and surgical strategies to manage the symptoms associated with these chronic rare neuro-immune disorders
- Gain knowledge on current and future basic science research and clinical studies that will improve the quality of life of our community
