


Join us for a fun Walk-Run-N-Roll

About The TMA:

The TMA is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit disease advocacy organization, focused on rare neuro-immune diseases, including Acute Disseminated Encephalomyelitis (ADEM), Neuromyelitis Optica (NMO), Optic Neuritis (ON) and Transverse Myelitis (TM). These diseases can affect children and adults at any age by causing inflammation of the spine, brain or optic nerve. Disability and paralysis may occur. TMA provides services such as camps for children and families, supports awareness though education and fosters basic science and clinical research.

There is no cure but early diagnosis may lead to a better outcome.
